This includes disassembling the lift truck, rebuilding the engine, sandblasting the lift and then reassembling the whole thing and finishing with a fresh coat of paint.

To meticulously rebuild a forklift engine, a good company will first entirely disassemble it. A heat cleaning system is then used to clean all of the parts. Once this step has been done, all of the parts are checked to see if they have any breakage, any extensive wear or any defects. Certain parts such as connecting rods, cylinder heads, crankshafts and cylinder blocks are resurfaced, resized and reground if considered necessary. Other parts like for example gears, nuts, bolts and so on. are repaired or replaced as needed.

When the overhaul has been done, the engine is rebuilt by hand. After being put back together, a series of tests are applied to the working machinery so as to check all of the parts and make sure there are no leaks or issues. If any problems occur, the needed modifications are done.

There should be no reason to be worried about buying a reconditioned or refurbished lift truck from quality sellers. The process of rebuilding the equipment guarantees the utmost in reliability. Repairs costs may really work out to be less since you will avoid the initial phase of higher repairs projections which a new forklift has as it is broken in.
